Visit the World Peace Pagoda, situated on a hilltop, to witness panoramic views of Pokhara and the surrounding mountains. Explore the enchanting Davis Falls and the mystical Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave. Pokhara also serves as a gateway to various trekking routes in the Annapurna region.
